

# B2B – take-back concept – information on taking back old appliances

Status January 2023

In accordance with EU Directive 2002/96/EC of the European Parliament and the EU Council on Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) and the new version of the EU Directives, 2012/19/EU, there is an obligation to collect electrical and electronic equipment, treat it in accordance with regulations, dispose of it and finance this.

Electrical and electronic equipment that has become waste is referred to as waste equipment. Owners of old appliances must dispose of them separately from unsorted municipal waste. In particular, old appliances do not belong in household waste, but in special collection and take-back systems.

According to the German Electrical and Electronic Equipment Act (§7a ElektroG), every manufacturer is obliged to create a reasonable opportunity for the return of old appliances.

Help us to dispose of electrical appliances in an environmentally friendly way. Valuable raw materials can be recovered through professional, environmentally friendly recycling. This protects our environment and our remaining resources.

We offer you the opportunity to return your old appliance to us..

The return shipment is at the sender's expense. There are no costs for the disposal of old appliances for the sender.
